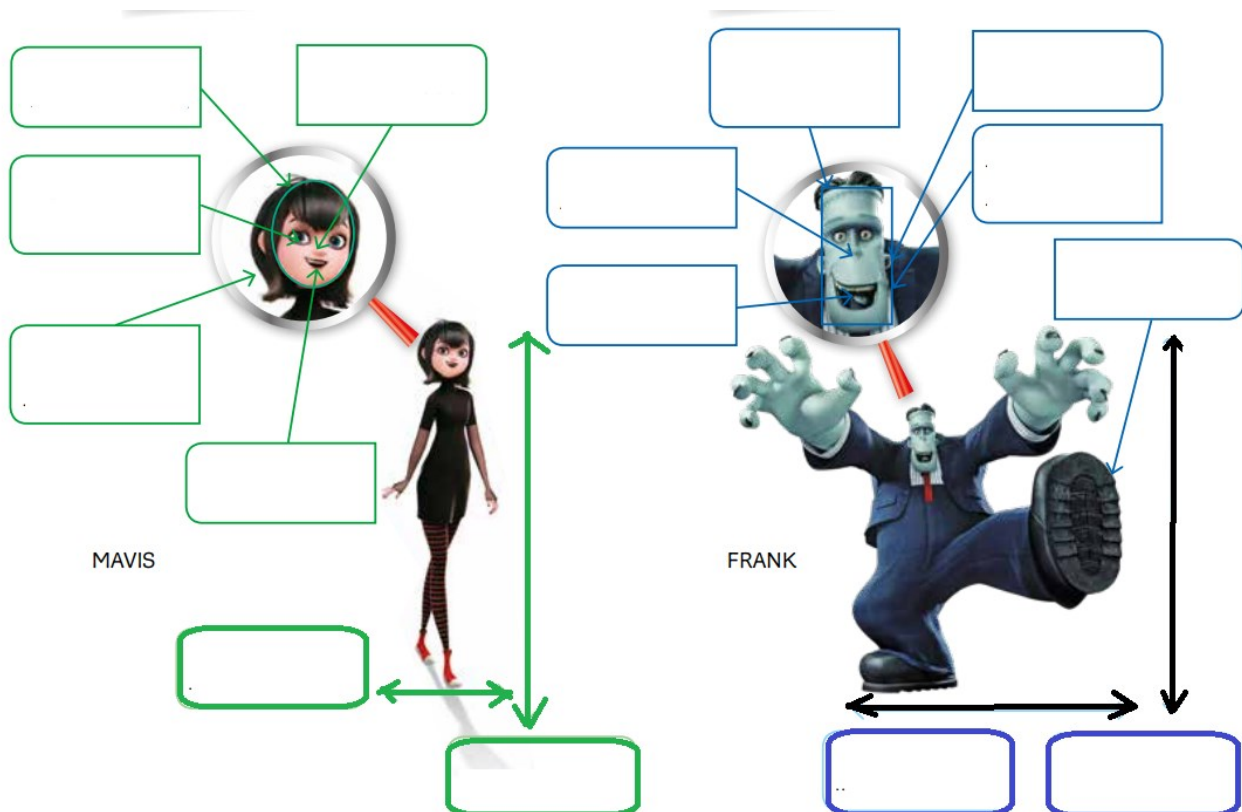
Dans le groupe nominal, l'adjectif se place avant le nom. Il est invariable.

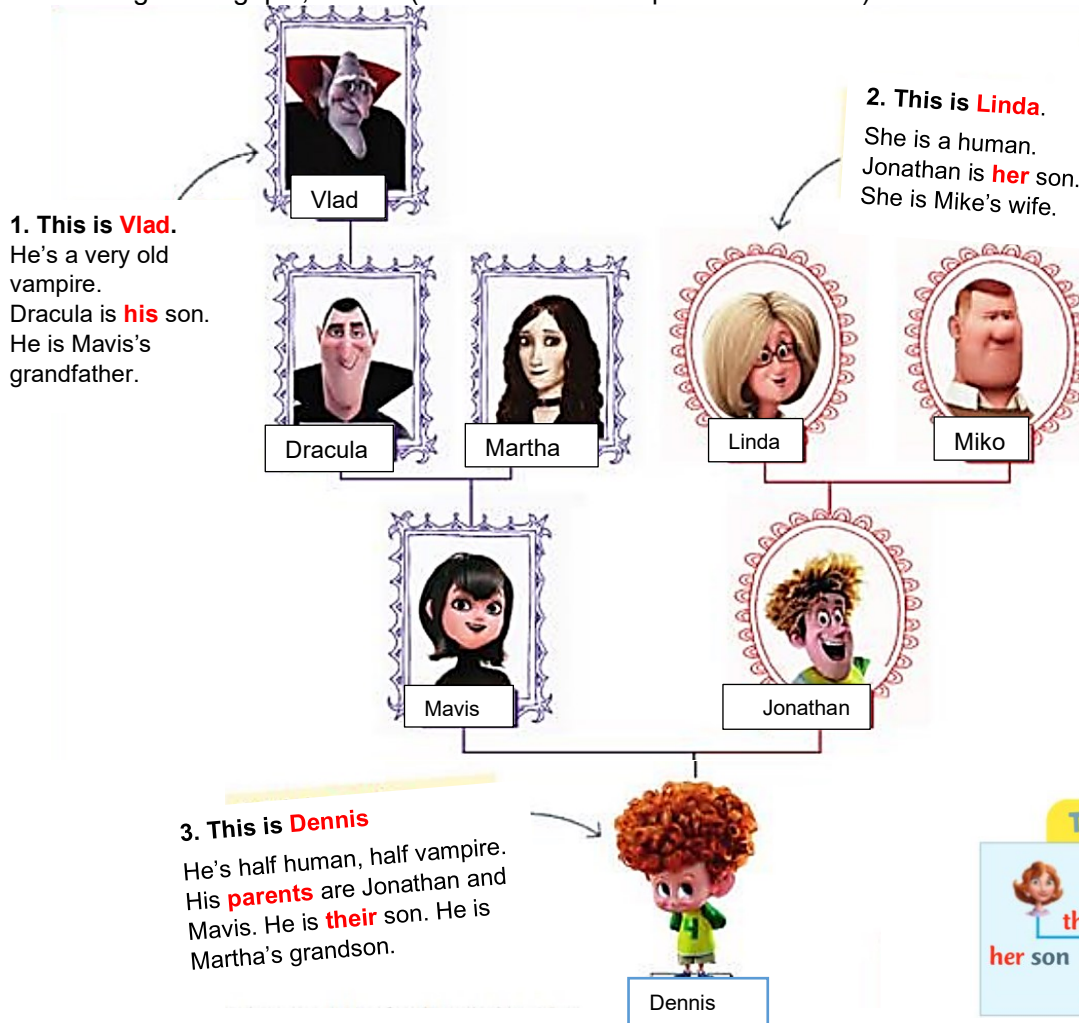
